Summerfield Chili Cook-off regulations and guidelines:

1. Meet at the Summerfield Fire Department on Summerfield Road at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, March 13, 2010, to get set up.
Note: *Tables and extension cords will be ready for contestants to plug in crock pots to keep chili warm.*
2. Please bring all chili already cooked. There will not be facilities to prepare food.
3. Chili may be "tweaked" and seasonings added on site. However, items must be pre-cooked.
Note: *a small cooler may be brought to store cold items.*
4. Contestants may bring condiments for tasters to add to the chili.
5. **Bring at least two (2) gallons of chili** so that there is plenty for the public to taste.
6. Crock-Pots of Chili must be labeled according to category ("**traditional**", "**spicy**" or "**other**")
7. Each contestant may bring one (1) guest (free of charge) to the event. Any additional people over the age of twelve (12) will be \$6
8. Items that will be available and provided are as follows: extension cords, tables, tablecloth, chairs, tasting cups, spoons and napkins (for contestants, visitors and judges). Items not listed will not be supplied.
9. The Fire Department is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.
10. All chili must be prepared and ready to be judged by 1:00 p.m..
11. All tables must be ready to serve the public for the Chili Tasting by 11:30 pm.
12. Concessions will be available for sale.

Judging Information

1. Each entry will be judged strictly for flavor in each category.
2. Judging will be "blind" (the judges will not know who entered any particular entry)
3. Prizes for top entries will be awarded at the end of the event.
4. There will be 1 "top prize" given for each category. Further, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded.
5. A "People's Choice" award will also be given to the contestant with the most tasters' votes.
